### **10:45 Review of Disciplinary Procedures**

- 3 member panel from Executive Board
- Overview of procedures when incidents arise
- Citation process- no official citing officer, but clubs can always submit citations
  - Will require 'proof' to result in any sanctions, but can at least inform the Disciplinary Committee of the incident (video is very helpful)
- CIPP process- required for all participants (players and referees)

### **10:50 Union Functioning and Competition Protocols**

- Advised to obtain club data through the USA Rugby database prior to reorganization
- Referees: Chris Schuyler is President, Peter Watson has stepped down
  - Other options beyond NERRS
  - Review procedure for obtaining a referee
- B-side requirement protocols (no requirement for full match, but should play some sort of B-side)
- Rostering requirements (CMS), and roster checks are always an option
- Matches can be played under protest- must be announced prior to the match

    - Use the schools as a resource
  - Regional Cup Tournament
    - Chance for college coaches to recruit and network
  - National Development Tour events
    - Youth track
  - 5 State Rugby Organizations in New England
  - Review of NDS and upcoming courses
- **Review of USA Rugby Landscape**
    - Financial difficulties from the national office
      - Misuse of member dues
      - Task Force organized to address issues
        - Working with silo stakeholders
        - GU Leaders demanded to place their own member (Kirk Tate- Texas Rugby Union)
      - NSCRO (soon to be NCRO) stepped up to lead college rugby
      - Funds will run out within the next few months, with reorganization to be finalized by August 2020
    - GU Leader Feedback
      - Timeline is unreasonable
      - Reorganization does not address the current issues comprehensively
      - Club option/plans:
        - Wait for reorganization plans
        - Pursue autonomy without USA Rugby
          - Insurance
          - Competition structure/Championships
